Today we will be considering one of the important tools required for couples to succeed in their marital lives which is "Effective Communication in Marriage". Our bible text is taken from Ephesians 4:29 which says,

"Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers."

"It is said that communication is the basis of life. In fact, Gerald R. Ford, a former president of the United State once said,

"Nothing in life is more important than the ability to communicate effectively".

However, it is not enough to just communicate with your spouse, for it to be effective, you need to ensure that you pass across the message you want and get the appropriate feedback. This is because effective communication promotes intimacy and emotional connection between couples. It also helps them build trust and respect and increases their ability to work together to solve problems. On the other hand, poor communication can lead to all kinds of misunderstandings in marriage and ultimately lead to separation or divorce.

Experts have said that when we talk with another person there are six messages that can come through.

- 1. What you mean to say.
- 2. What you actually said.
- 3. What the other person heard.
- 4. What the other person thinks he heard.
- What the other person says about what you said.

6. What you think the other person said about what you said.

So how can couples prevent poor communication in their marriages?

Since communication is both verbal and non-verbal, couples should guard their tongues from speaking words that could hurt their spouses, regardless of how they are feeling in the heat of the moment. Furthermore, they should also not behave in ways that could create barriers in their communication.

Some examples of barrier creating behaviours are:

- a. Anger
- b. Pride
- c. Impatience
- d. Lack of trust
- e. Bitterness
- f. And unforgiveness

When we speak respectfully to our spouses and treat them with kindness, gentleness, patience, self-control and forgiveness, it will improve communication in our marriages. The result is that our homes will be peaceful, happy and strong.
